You recently received a letter informing you that PSE&G planned to upgrade the electric system in your neighborhood. Please disregard that letter, as plans for the project have changed. We apologize for any inconvenience this may have caused, and thank you for your understanding as we improve electric service reliability for your neighborhood and the region.

Based on discussions with township officials and feedback from residents, PSE&G has determined that it can relocate the line down South Avenue along an existing pole line. The project will no longer involve work on Scotch Plains Avenue, Shackamaxon Drive, Rahway Avenue, Grove Street, Central Avenue, or Sycamore Street.
